

VISUAL ANALYSIS ESSAY PAINTING

Need help writing a Visual Analysis Essay? See my tips and writing instructions with sample essays for help analyzing ads, art, photographs.

Document details such as the artist, when it was created, any characters or objects in the visual, background setting, colors used, type of materials used, etc. One of the photos taken by Fridtjof Nansen depicted Russian famine. We all know that the purpose of the introduction, apart from stating our thesis and perception towards this specific piece of artwork, is also to capture attention of the audience. Following this you will need to describe the subject, theme, content, background and ideas ascertained from the piece. Always proofread your essay. The photo was used to raise money during that period.

Pre-writing Questions Use the pre-writing questions below to help you analyze your images and start writing notes that will help you develop your paper ideas. You can certainly write about a painting not listed here. The audience should make sense of what the essay writer is presenting by reading the first paragraph. Use the information you documented to form your visual analysis piece. When analyzing an image, describe the artwork as if you are presenting it to someone who has not seen the picture. What was the approximate era or period when it was made? A visual analysis conclusion needs to reiterate the thesis using different wordings. As any type of essay, the visual analysis one will consist of introduction, body and conclusion. Check that your argument makes logical sense through the essay. Students are supposed to think on the topic and content of the essay by interpreting and analyzing the visual stimulus which might be in the form of a photograph, a portrait, a painting, a sculpture or any kind of artistic object that has some amount of graphical element in it. Another important thing that should be kept in mind while writing the essay is that the paragraphs should both be assertive as well as creative in nature. See how the different elements of design work together to produce a mood or meaning. What details contribute to this effect? What is the overall theme, motif or symbol that the artwork is trying to convey to the reader? The most important thing, however, in the opening of the visual analysis essay is to introduce the audience with the artwork that is going to be examined and to state your attitude and the response you are looking for. Restate the thesis statement. The figure in the foreground depicts an overcrowded ship that is seen as desolate in a polluted landscape. Make every word count. A conclusion summarizes all the main points covered during the analysis. What is the approximate era or time it refers to? Conclusion present new idea or insight the writer has gained the artwork during analysis. How would the image appeal to that audience? Photo postcard sold to raise money for famine victims. Which details suggest informality?

Example of the 1st body paragraph The Last Voyage is a painting by Soto presenting human-like characteristics presenting an isolated land that is similar to earth. The photo was produced on postcards sold to raise money and raise awareness of the effects of famine in Russia. Pressed for time? Family Group by William Glackens Use single words or phrases to describe the following clues about how the people in the painting relate to each other. This involves explaining aspects such as: What the visual meant to the artist compared to what it means to you. I would strongly advise you to select a realistic painting that depicts people. What impression do the details of the painting create? To write one, use an outline whatever manner makes the most sense to you. What contrasts? Develop a thesis which presents your unique insights into the painting you analyze. Use questions in the pre-writing sections for ideas.
